NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Centre Nautique de Lorient

2. ADMISSIBILITY

The event is open to Grand Surprise boats.

The number of people registered by boat is limited to 10.

The skipper and 3 team-members will have to form part of the crew throughout all race. The other crew members will be allowed to sail at the day.

The sailing ships will have to be approved of category coastal, and armed according to their category.

Each French competitor will require a current 2007 FFV licence, bearing a medical endorsement.

Foreign competitors will have to present a valid insurance certificate.

4. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2005/2008, the prescriptions of the French Sailing Federation, the current class rules.

Rules in category C, annexes section II of the RRS 2005/2008 will apply.

5. SCORING

Low points system will apply.

The maximum number of races to be sailed will be 8. The event will be valid if 3 races are sailed, if 3 or more races are sailed, the worst result will be discarded from the final score.

6. TYPE OF COURSE

Upwind/downwind legs or coastal courses

7. PENALTY

Article 44.2 of the RRS 2005/2008 will apply.

8. SPECIFIC RULES

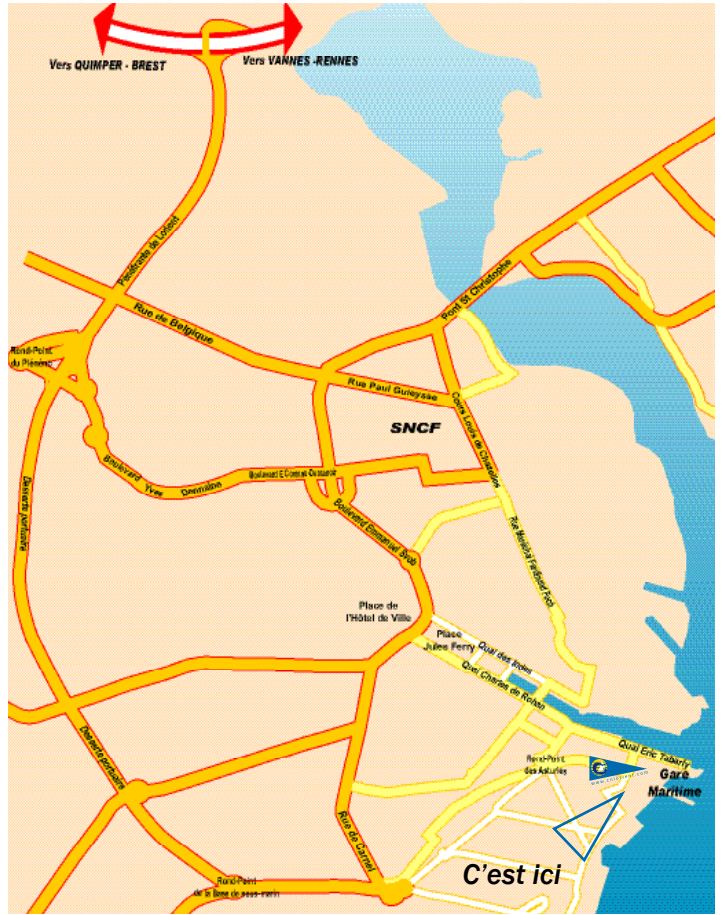
In accordance with the local administrative rules, all the sailing ships will have to conform to the particular race instructions relating to the circulation of the ships to the accesses and in the roads of Lorient and appearing in the race instructions or their appendices.

9. SECURITY RULES

Recall: in the event of sending of the Y flag by the race committee, port of the life jacket is mandatory.

11 PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The harbour reception will be made with the Marina of Lorient Centre (pontoon visitor between the "Maison de la Mer" and the boat museum "Thalassa ").

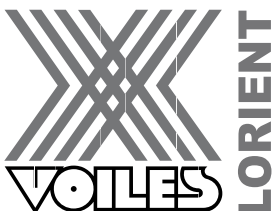
